Instructions for completing the Scholarship Application

We are accepting applications for Kansas Rainbow Scholarships. Eligible Rainbow Girls are active Rainbow girls and Majority Rainbow girls. All applicants must have completed or are graduating their Senior Year in High School or equivalent. Those interested in applying for a scholarship must complete an application and mail it in by the deadline of June 1. Only applications complete with all requested materials and signatures and postmarked by the deadline will be considered for a scholarship. Applications are available from your Mother Advisor or from the website.

Any <u>eligible</u> Rainbow Girl pursuing post-high school education, in a technical program, 2-year college degree, or 4-year college degree, is eligible and encouraged to apply. If the number of applications received exceeds the funds available, preference will be given to those who have completed at least one year of post-high school education.

You must complete the <u>entire</u> application. We want your full name, date of birth (month, day <u>and</u> year), complete address, phone number and name of home assembly. If you are a Majority Member, give the year you received your majority. If you are a Member of the Grand Cross of Color, give the year you received this honor.

Give the name and graduation date (month and year) of your high school.

If you were a graduating senior, we need your high school GPA and a copy of your high school transcript. No applications will be accepted without a transcript.

If you were enrolled in a technical program or college, we need your cumulative college GPA and a copy of your college transcript. No applications will be accepted without a transcript.

Mark the year you most recently completed (Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior).

List other awards or offices held in school, church or other organizations.

List the Grand Appointments you have held (including Personal Pages and Fraternal Correspondents/Grand Representatives) and the year you served in each office.

Sign and date your application.

You must also have <u>ONE</u> additional signature - your Mother Advisor <u>OR</u> an Advisory Board Member <u>OR</u> an Grand Executive Committee Member.

Your completed application and a copy of your transcript must be mailed and postmarked by June 1.

Only complete applications and those post marked by June 1 will be eligible for consideration.

If a scholarship is awarded, the amount of the scholarship will be sent to the college or technical school once documentation has been received that the applicant has been successfully enrolled.
